Two traits are named here. Why are they so important?

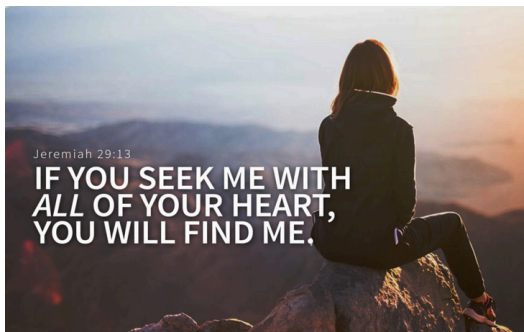
kheh'-sed (Heb.) = mercy, kindness, goodness, lovingkindness
we'ë'meṭ (Heb.) = truth, faithfulness, loyalty

6 Seek his will in all you do,
and he will show you which path to take.*

Respond & Apply: Individual & Small Group Discussion Guide

Take some time to reflect on the Shema from Deuteronomy 6:4-9

Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. ⁵ And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. ⁶ And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. ⁷ Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. ⁸ Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. ⁹ Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

How do you do live this out in everyday life?

Where is God showing up through other people right now?
